

As a seventeen year old, Ron J. Miller joined the United States Army. Sgt. 1st Class,

Ronald J. Miller was a member of the 101st and 82nd Airborne divisions. He was also a Green Beret in the Special Forces.

As an 18 year veteran, he proudly served his country during the height of the Cold War in Okinawa, Germany, and Vietnam. Sgt Miller was mortally wounded while on a night patrol May 6, 1968. He succumbed to his injuries and died on a naval hospital ship 6 days later on May 12, 1968. Sgt. Ronald J Miller, as a result of his bravery and valor during the Vietnam conflict, earned the Bronze Star for Valor and Purple Heart. Although it has been more than forty years since his death, his children still mourn the loss of their father. We the children, of Sgt Ronald Miller will always be thankful for his memories he has left us and for his sacrifice to the security of this great nation.
